Joining the Blocks: Quilt-As-You-Go Style with Melody Crust

Learn to join pre-quilted blocks using several innovative techniques. Go home ready to make larger machine quilted quilts without all the work of trying to get it into your machine. The Quilt-As-You-Go method allows for more detailed quilting using a standard sewing machine since you're only quilting a small section at a time.

<u>Supplies</u>

3 Quilted Quilt blocks 5 x 10" (firm batting works best)

Option: use pre-quilted fabric

Fat guarter fabric for front and back sashing strips

Fat quarter batting

Rotary cutter, mat and ruler (medium size)

Sewing machine

Walking foot (Frequently an extra item with open toe capability if possible) <u>OR</u> open toe embroidery foot

Seam ripper

Thread snips

Thread to match the sashing strips

Size 75/11 quilting needles

Pins

Optional, but nice

Chair cushion
